We try to feature special items each month and love to promote local foods. This month's features: A large multifunctional pot for tempting soups and stews and a professional grade cutlery set.

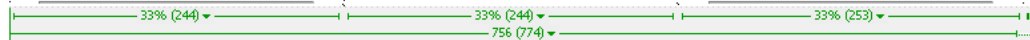
The knife blades are solid stainless steel, precision forged as one single piece. The heavy bolsters provide balance and control. The cutting edge holds its sharpness well. The five knives come with a handsome butcher block knife stand. They are dishwasher safe, but hand washing is recommended.

This is one of our most requested desserts. It is simple, elegant, and refreshing. You will need a small electric ice cream maker to produce the best results.



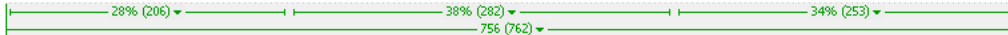
Cranberry Ice

- 3 pts. fresh cranberries
- 1 1/2 pts. sugar
- juice of 1 1/2 lemons
- 1 cup whipping cream
- dash salt

Directions:

Boil cranberries in 3 pints of water. When soft, strain. Add the sugar to the juice and bring to a brisk boil. Cool. Add the lemon juice and freeze to a soft mush. Stir in whipping cream and freeze in an ice cream maker. Serves 14.

Children's Cooking Class for March: Oven Chicken Fingers, Chocolate Chip Cookies

This month we will be baking oven chicken fingers that are dipped in a milk and egg mixture, then coated with breadcrumbs. The chocolate chip cookies are based on a famous recipe that includes chocolate chips, M&Ms, oatmeal, and pecans. Yummy! We will be learning some of the basics like how to cream butter and crack eggs without dropping shells into the batter.

We will provide French fries, green beans, fruit salad, and a beverage to accompany the chicken fingers.

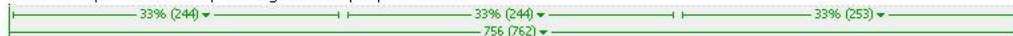


Adult Cooking Class for March: Chinese Cuisine

The class in March will be cooking several traditional Chinese dishes: Peking dumplings, wonton soup, fried rice, Chinese vegetables, and shrimp with lobster sauce. For dessert: banana spring rolls.



This looks easier than it is! Chef Carolyn is demonstrating the first steps in making Chinese dumplings, known as *jiaozi* (pronounced geeow dz). Notice that she is using a traditional wooden rolling pin to roll out the dough. These dumplings were stuffed with pork and then steamed, although other popular fillings are made with chicken and leeks or vegetables with spiced tofu and cellophane noodles. Dumplings can be steamed, boiled, or fried, and have unique names depending on the preparation method.
